PRISCILLA ANN STARR, PIONEER

Aged Woman Dies Here; T. J. Wilkins
and Lottis Delbert Lukey Succumb

The death of Mrs. Priscilla Ann Starr, which occurred at the home of her daughter, Mrs. W. H. Leonard, removes one of the early pioneers of the northwest.

In 1852, when with her husband, William Henderson Starr, she arrived at Lebanon, Oregon, after crossing the plains with an ox team train, she found a new country, and thirteen years later when they settled upon land four miles east of Waitsburg, the fertile Touchet valley had been scarcely scarred by the early settlers' plow.

Mrs. Starr was born in Jackson county, Missouri, December 4, 1832 the daughter of Isaac and Izza Crabtree. In April 1853, she married William Henderson Starr, who died several years ago on the Touchet farm.

Besides Mrs. Leonard, Mrs. Martha Liddle of Colfax, another daughter survives her, and a sister, Mrs. Malinda Boulton, of Long Beach, California. Both daughters were present at the time of her death and the sister had visited her two weeks before.

The body was taken to Huntsville, where funeral services were conducted Sunday, Oct. 15, by Rev. J. A. Ford, pastor of the Baptist church of Dayton. Interment was made at Waitsburg.

Mrs. Starr had spent the last thirteen months with her daughter in Pomeroy, but up to that time the Starr farm on the Touchet had been her home since 1867.

Her kindly treatment and consideration of all persons remain a cherished memory among the old-timers who still linger.

The Starr bridge which spans the Touchet near Huntsville derived its name in the early days from the Starr family.—East-Washingtonian.

GEORGE W. CRALL, one of the earliest residents of Columbia county, Washington, was born seven miles from Tiffin, Seneca county, Ohio, his parents being Henry and Melinda Crall. His father was a native of Frederick county, Maryland, the son of a German who emigrated to this country. On the mother's side, the grandparents of our subject were from Ireland.

G. W. Crall was reared in Ohio, and had passed his thirtieth year when he left there and moved to Wayne county, Iowa. He was married in that county, and in 1862 crossed the plains to Oregon, coming by the old emigrant trail and Lander's cut-off. For two years after his arrival on the coast, he resided in Oregon, near Portland, then moved to the Washington side of the Columbia, and after two or three years spent there came to Columbia county, where he took up 160 acres of land in what is now known as Crall hollow. Here he has since resided, and the neighborhood still bears his name.

His wife was formerly Lucinda Cross, a native of Illinois, and a daughter of Micajah Cross, now of Dayton. They have nine children, viz.: John Henry; Tabitha Ellen, wife of Zachariah Munden, of this county; Sophia, wife of Emmett Swan; and Charles, Franklin, Amos, Sarah Jane, Belle and Eveline.

Mr. Crall has always been a consistent adherent to the principles of the Democratic party, and in former days occasionally attended the county conventions of his party as delegate. He has never been an office-seeker, but has served his school district in the capacity of Director. In fact, he was the first settler in his neighborhood and was a staunch worker for the location of the first school in his district. Mr. Crall has been an eye-witness to most of the material growth of Columbia county, and has always been recognized as one of its most upright and conscientious citizens.
